**Directions:** *University House* (building no. 28 on map) adjoins the Students' Union. The entrance is near the traffic barrier at the junction of Cromer Terrace and Lifton Place. The function rooms are all on the second floor. *Wheelchair access* to this floor is via the lift in the Refectory entrance to the building (i.e. between the Students' Union and University House entrances). From the lift go straight ahead through the double doors; the entrance to the second floor is at the end on the right hand side (through a second set of double doors).
