

Authorship of BERA Academic and Professional User Reviews of Research

1. Introduction

A final glance was shot to the in-house practices and publications. *British Educational Research Journal* has already been included in the analysis of journal articles' authorship. Another area of output for BERA is that of commissioned reviews, in both an academic series (4 reviews to date) and a professional one (7 reviews). It might be interesting to have a look at the distribution of authorship of these reviews (in terms of institutional affiliation). The tables below only include the main authors or lead editors of each review.

Authors/ editors from institutions graded 5-5* at RAE 2001: 3

Authors/ editors from institutions graded 4 at RAE 2001: 2

Authors/ editors from institutions graded 3a at RAE 2001: 2

Authors/ editors from other institutions: 1

Total: 8 authors/editors, 3 from 5-5*, 4 from 4 and under, 1 from other institution

Professional user reviews (7 reviews):

Authors/ editors from institutions graded 5-5* at RAE 2001: 5

Authors/ editors from institutions graded 4 at RAE 2001: 1

Authors/ editors from institutions graded 3a at RAE 2001: 2

Authors/ editors from other institutions: 1

Total: 9 authors/editors, 5 from 5-5*, 3 from 4 and under, 1 from other institution
