## FOREWORD

The Catalogue of the Safe at Carlton Hill Meeting House was prepared in manuscript in 1910 under the supervision of Gervase Lawson Ford on the basis of earlier catalogues. Amendments and additions were made over the next half-century, and an inventory in abbreviated form was prepared and duplicated in 1972, and appeared as no. 26 in the Brotherton Library Special Collections Handlist series. That inventory was replaced by an expanded record (Handlist 55, 1983; and Addenda, Handlist 79, 1987), excluding from notice archives which had been removed (for one reason or another) from the Safe at Carlton Hill between 1910 and the transfer of documents to Leeds University Library (Special Collections) in 1979.

A second edition was issued as Handlist 99 in 1997. It represented a revision of previous lists, and included items that had been added to the collection since 1987.

The preparation of the current digitised version of Handlist 99, first issued in April 2005, has provided the opportunity to update the contents in various ways. Material continues to be added to the collection, and it is intended that the digitised handlist should reflect new additions as quickly as possible.

The records (comprising more than 1000 volumes and over 400 files of loose papers) are maintained in secure, environmentally controlled conditions, and are made available for research within the Special Collections department of Leeds University Library, subject to any restrictions necessary for manuscripts in a frail state. Ownership of the records remains with the Society of Friends.

*The conditions of deposit of the records in Leeds University Library include a clause requiring prior written permission from an appointed Custodian for access to consult current legal documents and any material less than fifty years old. Photocopying of records of any date requires similar written permission from a Custodian.*

The Custodians are appointed by the body 'Quakers in Yorkshire', formerly known as Yorkshire General Meeting. ## INTRODUCTION

### *Contents*

The Carlton Hill collection of archives contains records of meetings of the Society of Friends for the mid-part of the old West Riding of Yorkshire (now divided between West and North Yorkshire), and a few records of the county Quarterly Meeting.

More precisely, the documents cover the area included before the middle of the nineteenth century in the old Settle, Knaresborough and Brighouse monthly meetings, which range from the districts around Bentham, Settle, Airedale, Newton and Lothersdale (Settle Monthly Meeting) in the north west, to Skipton, Addingham, Darley, and Rawdon (Knaresborough Monthly Meeting) in the north, and to Bradford, Leeds, Gildersome, Halifax, Brighouse and Huddersfield (Brighouse Monthly Meeting) in the south.

When Knaresborough Monthly Meeting was dissolved in 1853, Harrogate and Darley (then sole representative of the old Nidderdale Meeting) were joined to York Monthly Meeting, but the rest of the area was joined to Brighouse Monthly Meeting, and the records came to Leeds. So it is that there are three series of monthly meeting records for this region, comprising the areas of Settle, Brighouse and Knaresborough meetings, running down from the seventeenth century (Brighouse from 1688, Knaresborough from 1721 (Women's meeting from 1677), Settle from 1666).

### *Arrangement*

The arrangement of the collection preserves the sequence which obtained when the deposit was received from the Society of Friends, and the inventory follows closely the order in which the volumes are shelved. Reference numbers, which are given in the left-hand margin of the page, consist of a letter or letters (indicating the boxes in which the manuscripts were kept when in the Safe at Carlton Hill Friends' Meeting House), followed by arabic numbers indicating the individual items within the letter division. (Series of loose papers are further subdivided numerically, although these numbers are not detailed in this brief Inventory.) Additions to the collection received since 1979 have been allotted appropriate reference numbers using the same system.

Summary descriptions of the archives relating to each separate Quaker meeting or other Quaker body within the Carlton Hill collection are included in Leeds University Library's main public catalogue (<http://lib.leeds.ac.uk/>). A classmark search for the phrase 'manuscripts ms dep. 1979/1' will bring up the records for all relevant collections, in alphabetical order of name.

### *Indexes*

An index to the current inventory (principally names of meetings and of places) will be found at the end. An index of personal names occurring in many of the older minutre books is available in the form of the Quaker Archives Database (<https://bei.leeds.ac.uk/FreeSearch/LIBSPCOL/Quakers/>), which has been created from pre-existing typescript indexes. Entries in the database refer to page numbers within handlist volumes (e.g. Carlton Hill A2), indicating also the Meeting and span of years concerned (in this case, Knaresborough Monthly Meeting, 1754-75).
