Live Music Now (LMN) was established in 1977 by Yehudi Menuhin, and they are now the largest music outreach organisation in the UK giving over 3000 interactive performances and workshops per year, around 600 of which take place in the Yorkshire & Lincolnshire region. They work exclusively with young musicians at the start of their professional careers providing them with paid performance opportunities as well as access to training and skills development which supports their CPD as both performers and music leaders. At any one time we have around 300 musicians on the scheme, and at the moment just four are based in the Yorkshire and Lincolnshire region. It is for this reason that Arts Council England, Yorkshire are supporting a round of auditions in Leeds, to help us to increase the number of young musicians we are working with and to try and retain some of the talent in Yorkshire by providing paid employment. To help encourage musicians to come forward to audition they are having a series of open days and pre-audition days to give musicians a chance to find out more about what they do, and to get help in preparing for their audition.

Teach First is an influential charity that is delivering far-reaching social and economic change by addressing educational disadvantage – driving up standards and raising expectations in some of the UK’s most challenging schools. Their approach is to attract high-calibre, highly motivated graduates into an initial two year leadership development programme focusing on the achievements and aspirations of pupils and their access to further opportunities in education and beyond. Through the Leadership Development Programme, participants become inspiring teachers, leaders, role models and agents of change. They gain valuable leadership development to prepare them for influential careers, either in education or elsewhere. In their first year, participants work towards gaining Post Graduate Certificate in Education (PGCE) as well as have the opportunity to study for a Masters qualification in the second year. After that, long term systemic change comes from continued engagement with education through the Teach First Ambassador Movement.
