Thank you for your Freedom of Information (FOI) request dated 30 January 2020, reference K/20/054.

Your request read:

“How many unauthorised access or attempted accesses was there on university computers or the internet network operated by the university, of pornographic websites or websites from which students and staff were banned from accessing, and which if they were found to have done so, could have resulted in disciplinary proceedings being taken against them, or some other sanction in the years 2018 and 2019 please supply data for calendar years not academic years

Please list the name of the websites including the URL”

The University of Leeds does not hold this information.

The University’s [Use of Computer Systems Policy](#) sets out that staff and students should not access pornographic websites unless they have been formally granted an exception (normally for research purposes). We do not keep logs of web sites visited by staff and students as a matter of course, but would investigate if a specific allegation were made.
