Thank you for your clarified Freedom of Information (FOI) request dated 12 October 2020, reference K/20/375

Your clarified request read:

“[The number of] Reports of sexual harassment/abuse/violence which have occurred on campus grounds (which constitutes University grounds, buildings such as student unions, libraries, lecture buildings, and student halls) or harassment which has occurred online, during the period of 2016/2017, 2017/2018, 2018/2019 and 2019/2020.”

The University of Leeds holds some of this information.

We do not hold information regarding the location of incidents reported by students. As such, we are unable to identify any information relevant to your request which relates to incidents reported by students. We are, however, anecdotally aware of one incident which was reported to have occurred online.

We can advise that ten incidents reported by members of staff were reported to have taken place on campus grounds. No reports of online incidents have been made by staff.
