
Walking directions from Leeds City Train Station to the University of Leeds

Walking directions

Leeds City Train Station to the University of Leeds

- The University campus is a 20 minute walk from the train station. The map overleaf will help you find your way.
- Leave the station through the City Square doors from the North Concourse.
- Cross the road into City Square. If you wish to use the shuttle bus service, turn left past Banyan onto Infirmary Street, where the shuttle bus service departs from.
- To walk to campus, cross City Square and walk straight up Park Row.
- Continue up Park Row, passing The Slug and Lettuce and The Royal Bank of Scotland.
- At the crossroads at the top of the road turn right onto The Headrow, passing The Light shopping centre on your left.
- After The Light, before the road junction, turn left onto Albion Street, leading to Woodhouse Lane, to continue uphill.
- Keep going, passing Morrisons, Leeds Beckett University and the Dry Dock boat pub. Head for the large white clock tower in front of you.
- This is the Parkinson Building and the main entrance to the University.
